ACCUPLACER is a comprehensive battery of test designed to provide information about applicants reading, math and computer skills. Tests within the ACCUPLACER System are delivered over the internet and are used extensively with high schools, community colleges, four year colleges and technical schools around the world. The primary function of ACCUPLACER placement assessment is to assist with determining if applicants are prepared for college-level courses.
