After 27 years of owning the Culinary Institute Lenotre (CIL), Alain and Marie Lenotre have decided to retire beginning January 2026. We sincerely wish them the best and pray that they continue to be blessed with good health and happiness.

As your College Director and Chief Executive Officer, I would like to convey that the CIL leadership, staff, and faculty are committed to continuing to support and provide you with the education needed to achieve your academic goals during this transition and thereafter. - o Programs of Study: No changes to educational programs, curriculum, or degree requirements will occur as a direct result of this ownership change.
- o Student Aid: Your eligibility for Federal Student Aid (Title IV programs) is expected to continue without interruption.



Operations: The institution will continue to operate under the same name and at its current location.

- CIL has submitted a formal notification and required documentation to the U.S.
 Department of Education and will be submitting a formal application for approval of this change.
- o If the Department requires financial protection, the new owner will comply in accordance with federal regulations.
